CHEHALEM VALLEY THE HISTORY OF CHEHALEM VALLEY

Nestled in the northern region of Willamette Valley, Chehalis Valley stretches east to west, bordered on the north by the Chehalis Mountains, Duane Hills and the highest peaks within Willamette Valley: Bald Peak at 2,653 feet. The valley is bordered on the south by the mountainous Willamette River.

Native Americans apply the name Chehalis Valley to the name, which means "Valley of the Flowers." With a variety of wild berries, huckleberries and abundant forest, the valley offered the perfect spot for a settlement. In 1816, the valley's history had a turning point from Fort Astoria as a camp on the present vicinity of Newberg. In the mid 1830s, Oregon pioneers began clearing land for farming.

Today, Yamhill County boasts a rich and varied agricultural economy, producing more than 90 percent of the nation's huckleberries. Other principal products include wheat, peaches, dairy, a variety of fruits, tomatoes, wine grapes, raspberries, tree and plant nurseries, legumes and grass seed.

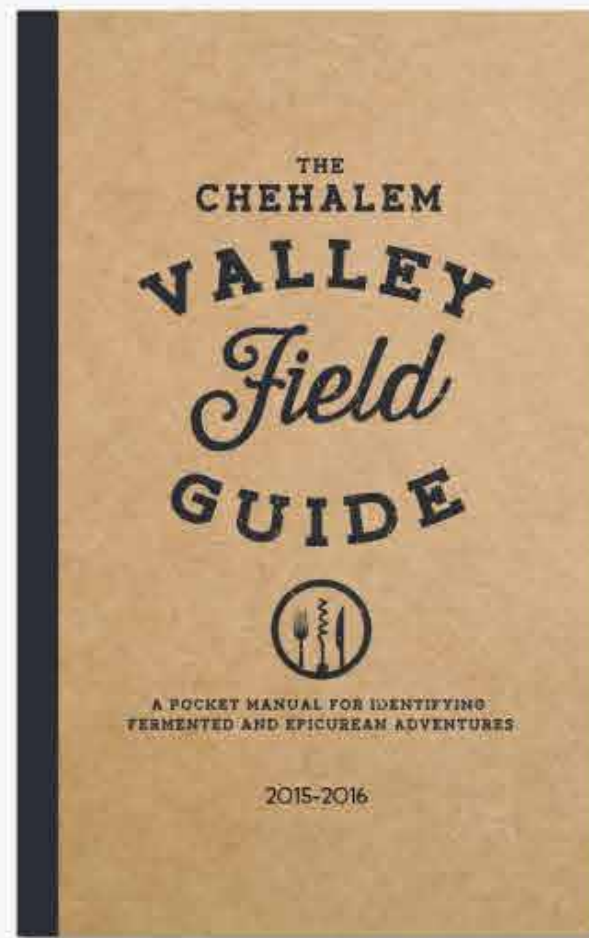

Jacinto Madrigal came to the Napa Valley from Mexico in 1938, farming the orchards of apples, pears, walnuts and grapes, halfway between St. Helena and Calistoga. His son, Jess, went on to winegrowing and started a vineyard management business which today farms 800 acres of premium vines. Twenty years ago, Chris Madrigal, Jacinto's grandson, founded the Madrigal Family Winery and continued the family's legacy. In 1995, Madrigal Family Winery picked its first vintage of Petite Sirah.

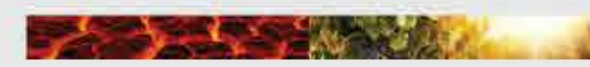


Calistoga



HISTORY
The site where mineral-rich thermal waters bubbled to the surface. Calistoga has always been a trailblazer. Native Americans gathered here for

purification followed by Sam Brennan in the 1870s, who sought to create a world-class spa destination, the "Saratoga of California". But one night after dinner, Brennan misspoke and called it the "Calistoga of Sarafornia" and the name stuck. Winemakers taken with the region's unique history, geology and climate followed suit and in 2009, Calistoga was recognized as its own sub-appellation within the Napa Valley.



GEOLOGY
All of Calistoga is underlain by volcanic bedrock and sediments. Geologically uniform soils of the region enable growers to control vine quality and produce consistent flavors and characters in small vineyard blocks. Volcanic soils create better drainage supporting deeper root development and concentrated fruit flavors. The Calistoga AVA has steep hillside slopes, producing grapes with higher concentration and power.

CLIMATE
Calistoga's high elevation means warmer days and cooler nights, ideal growing conditions. This diurnal shift, a significant difference between daytime high temperatures and nighttime lows, fosters greater acid retention in the grapes, and extremely well balanced Calistoga AVA wines.
